Our mission is to teach Gospel values in an environment of academic excellence that fosters the development of the whole person in a Catholic-Christian community.

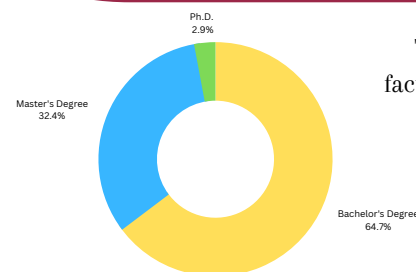

### Community

St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic High School (STA) is an elite college preparatory high school and the only parochial high school in Tangipahoa Parish with a student body of 320 students. The student body participates in academics, extra-curriculars and service prior to graduation. Each student is required to complete service hours annually. The graduation rate of the Senior Class is 100%. The student body diversity is 86% White, 11% Black, 2% Hispanic and 1% Asian. There is opportunity for financial assistance.

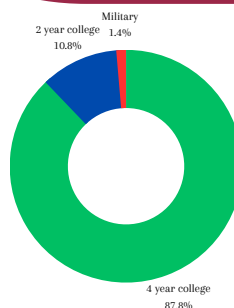
