# **STA Driver Education**

## **Parental Orientation**

- Leading Factors in Teen Driving Collisions

All parents must attend a parental meeting/orientation for each driver education course to be taught at St Thomas Aquinas, as required by the state of Louisiana.

The meeting for the January 9th class will be the evening of January 5th at 6:00 pm in the St Thomas commons. Domiciliary parent or legal guardian must attend. Please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate and a photocopy of their Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP).

Class fee of \$450 includes \$225 for the classroom instruction and \$225 for the behind the wheel instruction.

## **\*\*Attention Parents\*\***

Louisiana law requires all students that register for a driver education course to acquire a Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) prior to registration for the course. The TIP can be acquired at any FULL state DMV office. The Hammond office is an express office and cannot issue these permits. Any student that wishes to register for a course that does not have a TIP will not be allowed to take the final knowledge test or do the driving portion of the course, per the state of Louisiana. Two local DMV's that can issue these permits would be Amite and Livingston. Greensburg and Mandeville are also options. There are several forms that will be needed when taking your child to the DMV for these permits. They are as follows:

1. Original birth certificate
2. Social Security card
3. Picture ID for student
4. Parent ID
5. Proof of domiciliary parent if applicable

Passports can also be used. Also, if you would like your child to be issued the new REAL ID, bring two copies of bills that verify your name and current address. Student demographic sheet from their current school is a great option for the real ID.

It is very important that these permits are acquired before the parent meeting for the upcoming course so I can have a copy for their file. Please bring a photocopy of the TIP to the parent meeting that will be held prior to the beginning of the course. Also, please bring a photocopy of your child's birth certificate to that meeting as well.
