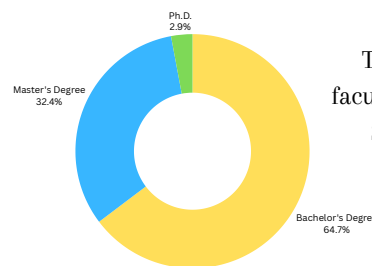
Our mission is to teach Gospel values in an environment of academic excellence that fosters the development of the whole person in a Catholic-Christian community.



### Community

St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic High School (STA) is a college preparatory high school, grades 8-12, as well as the only parochial high school in Tangipahoa Parish with a student body of 360. The student body participates in academics, extracurriculars and service prior to graduation. Each student is required to complete service hours annually. The graduation rate of the Senior Class is 100%. The student body diversity is 87% White, 12% Black, and 1% Other. There is opportunity for financial assistance. We accept the Gator, ACE, and ARETE Scholarships.

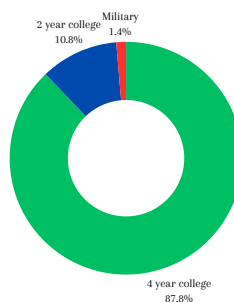
#### **Dual Enrollment (with Southeastern Louisiana University)**
